This is a great current events game!
It can be a great addition to any “free-reading” period.

Before you start the game, take about 20 minutes to read today’s edition of the Leader-Post. You can read the whole paper, or only concentrate on one section - City & Province, for instance.

Put the newspapers away and choose a student to go to the front of the classroom to become Mr. or Ms. Know-It-All.

Now the challenge starts! The other students ask him/her questions about the events reported in today’s Leader-Post. As long as the student answers correctly, they stay at the front. When the student is stumped, they return to their seat and the person who stumped them becomes the new Mr. or Ms. Know-It-All— providing they can answer their own question!
